## **Tech Tips and Tricks**

Welcome to our Tips and Tricks page. Here you will find some interesting and hopefully, new ideas to help you navigate your on line and digital world! This month we will look at some Excel Tips!

Working with shortcuts saves valuable time in your workday! Instead of accessing the toolbar with a mouse, two or three keystrokes are used to perform significant functions. Isn't that easier and time-saving? Using Excel shortcuts drastically increases the speed, and thus reduces work-time. Here are some Excel shortcuts

Save a Workbook	Ctrl + S
Go to the Data Tab	ALT + A
To go the Formula tab	ALT+ M
Italicize Font	ALT + I
Bold Font	ALT + B
To add a border	ALT + H + B
To insert the current date	Ctrl +;
To select the entire column	Ctrl + Space

If you would like to add the total to the bottom of a column or row you can do this with one entry!

- 1. In your spreadsheet click in the cell either at the bottom of a column or at the end of a row. (this is where you want the total to display)
- 2. Type Alt + =
- 3. Voila! You have the total!

Did you know that you can filter an excel sheet based on the information in one cell. If you want to find all the lines that apply to a certain criterion you can do this in one step!

- 1. In Excel right click on the cell you are trying to filter information for.
- 2. From the drop down menu choose Filter
- 3. Choose Filter based on selected cells value
- 4. Now you can highlight the filtered data and right click and choose copy
- 5. Open a new document or worksheet within the current document.
- 6. Right click and choose Paste.
- 7. DONE!
