



## **Tech Tips and Tricks**

Welcome to our Tips and Tricks page. Here you will find some interesting and hopefully, new ideas to help you navigate your on line and digital world!

Did you know that you can customize the look of your Office Applications like Outlook and Word and Excel. From any of these applications do the following:

- 1. Click on File
- 2. Choose Account
- 3. Click on the drop down menu for the Office Background. Choose the one you would like. Try School Supplies!
- 4. Click on the drop down menu for Office Theme, if you you prefer a darker background you can choose grey or black.

If you have a phrase or information that you often use in emails you can create a quick part to insert this into emails in a few clicks!

- 1. From an email where you have typed this information copy the text
- 2. Choose Insert from the menu
- 3. Choose Quick Parts
- 4. Choose Save Selection to Quick Part Gallery, then the Quick Part Dialog Box will open.
- 5. Here you can name your content and choose how you want it to be inserted, you can also create different folders for your Quick Parts.
- 6. When you would like to use your Quick Part you can either type the name you gave your Quick Part or you can choose Insert and select your Quick part from the list.

You can use Quick Steps to simplify repetitive steps, perhaps you have a category of emails you receive often and you save them to a specific folder.

- 1. In Outlook from the Quick Steps category choose Create New
- 2. Name your Quick Step
- 3. Choose an action from the list (Lets do a Reply of Thanks!) so Choose Reply
- 4. Choose More Actions
- 5. In the Text Area type Thanks!
- 6. Click Finish
- 7. When you want to use the Quick Step, choose it from your list in the menu
- 8. Click send in your message
