
President's Message...

Greetings everyone. It seems like the long awaited spring weather has finally arrived. Baseball season is underway, gardens are in bloom with a brilliance of tulips and daffodils, and many associations are holding their meetings as we approach the home stretch towards summer. We will be holding our own Annual Conference in October 2018 and I strongly encourage you to plan to attend.

As your President, I was given the opportunity to provide the welcome address the joint OCSTA/OCSBOA Business Seminar at the end of April. The Ontario Catholic School Trustees' Association (OCSTA) is our key partner in supporting Catholic education in the province. I am glad to have their support and that of their President, Patrick Daly.

The keynote speaker at the conference was Bonnie Lysyk, Auditor General of Ontario. Ms. Lysyk presented the results of the findings from their audit of, "School Boards' Management of Financial and Human Resources." The audit was conducted using a sample of four school boards (2 Catholic & 2 Public). Key audit findings are summarized as:

- Sick days for school board employees increased 29% over the last five years, causing the boards financial pressures;
- School boards are missing an opportunity to improve teaching quality through teacher performance appraisals;
- Student achievement results are not a key factor in the allocation of resources;
- Funding for students at risk of academic difficulty not always spent as intended;
- Language grant provided for English-language learners is being spent on other purposes;
- Nearly a quarter of special-needs students are waiting longer than a year to receive psychological assessments;
- · Specialist assessment wait times differed significantly based on the school area within the same board; and
- Operational improvements recommended by regional internal audits were not implemented.



These findings may be applicable to each of our respective school boards and as business officials we have a fiduciary duty to ensure that if areas for improvement are identified, they are assessed appropriately addressed. What differentiates us as Catholic boards is not the findings themselves, but rather the actions we take to address them. Our action plans and responses, as with everything we do, must be tempered by the teachings of our faith. This can best be summarized by a poster I saw in one of our schools, depicting the elemental symbol of Je, the Jesus element. This should serve as a reminder to each of us, that Jesus is the fundamental element in all Catholic organizations, and his teachings should guide everything we do. Have a wonderful spring!
